**Bring your photo ID. It is required to check in each day! Also bring this Newsletter, your Final Confirmation, and a list of your medications & health conditions.**

Your **Final Confirmation** is enclosed/attached. Review it carefully and bring it with you to State Finals. No changes can be made at the Games. As a courtesy to your fellow participants, notify NCSG in writing by email or USPS before the games if your plans change and you will **not** participate in any **one** of your activities. **You must present your photo ID each day at every activity to check in.**

We are so fortunate you are joining us and we hope you have a great time! We have made some changes to accommodate the volume: **doubles and singles will be played on both days two and three** and all games will be 1 game to 15, win by 1. In future years, it may be necessary to make other format changes to accommodate growth. Thank you for your patience as we endeavor to have an exceptional tournament for everyone!

#### Cancellation Deadline & Refunds

September 28 is the last day to cancel pickleball and/or request a refund or change registered partners. Your written (email or USPS) refund request must be received by NCSG by September 28. No refunds after this date. Refund checks will be mailed after State Finals ends in late October. There is a \$15 non-refundable processing fee for complete cancellations.

**State Finals is for Everyone!** Your safety and the sportsmanlike conduct of everyone is of paramount concern. State Finals officials have the authority to disqualify, and/or remove from current and future NCSG programs, anyone who exhibits inappropriate behavior or a condition of medical concern. #### Hotels, Directions & Parking

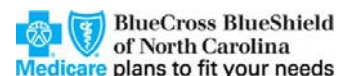

## Directions to Carolina Courts

### **From Charlotte or points west:**

#### I-85 North

- Take Exit 49: Bruton Smith Blvd/Concord Mills Blvd
- Turn right at end of ramp onto Bruton Smith Blvd
- Go 1.3 miles and turn left onto Highway 29 North (at Charlotte Motor Speedway)
- Continue on Hwy 29 North for 5.5 miles
- Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Cabarrus Ave West
- Move into left lane to continue straight on Cabarrus Ave West
- At the traffic circle, take the 2nd right to continue on Cabarrus Ave West .9 miles
- Turn right onto Spring St SW
- Entrance to Carolina Courts will be 200 ft on right (see next page for overflow parking map)

### **From Greensboro or points east:**

#### I-85 South

- Take Exit 60: Dale Earnhardt Blvd
- Turn left at end of ramp onto Dale Earnhardt, which becomes Copperfield Blvd
- Continue on Copperfield Blvd for 1.7 miles
- Turn left onto Branchview Dr SE (Hwy 3)
- Continue 2.6 miles on Branchview Dr SE
- Turn right onto Cabarrus Ave SE
- Continue .8 miles on Cabarrus Ave SE
- Turn left onto Spring St SW
- Entrance to Carolina Courts will be 200 ft on (see next page for overflow parking map)
