If you are using music and/or props as part of your routine, your group must have individuals (<u>not</u> in the routine) to assist the sound technician with cueing the music and to set up and remove your props quickly from the performing area. Props must be few, light weight and easy to quickly set up and remove.
I have read and understand the NCSG Cheerleader Guidelines (a copy is available from your Local Coordinator).
