SilverArts Follies

Saturday, November 17; Showtime 2:30 p.m.

A **required** "Technical Workshop" (not a rehearsal) will be held at **11:00 a.m. for acts 20-40** (as numbered below) and at **12:15 p.m. for acts 1-19**. Check-in for the *first* Workshop will open at 10:30 a.m. **Remember, you or the majority of your group, must attend the required Technical Workshop or you will not be permitted to perform in the show. The Workshop will answer all your questions and provide a chance to be on stage and test sound.**

All acts must enter **stage right**. Exceeding the 3-minute time limit will result in disqualification. **Timing** begins with the first note of music or the first movement visible to the audience and ends with the final note/movement of your act. The raised stage dimensions are 32 ft long x 24 ft deep. The stage floor surface is covered with a professional marley dance floor, as in past years. We plan to stream the Show live on the internet; it can be accessed at the link on the SilverArts page of our website. All music (CD or MP3) was due by August 1 and has been uploaded for the show.

Medals will be presented at intermission and at the conclusion of the show. Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to solo, small group, and large group in each subcategory – vocal, dance, comedy/drama, line dance and instrumental. There will be a reserved section in the back of the audience for performers only to watch the show live. Photography *is* permitted by the audience.
