Friday, September 25th

The required “**Technical Workshop**” (not a rehearsal) is at 3:15 pm. Check-in for the workshop is from 2:45 – 3:15 p.m. **Remember, you or the majority of your group, must attend the Technical Workshop or you will not be permitted to perform in the show. This workshop will answer all your questions and provide a chance to be on stage and to test sound.** All acts must enter stage right. Exceeding the 3-minute time limit will result in automatic disqualification. **Timing** begins with the first note of music or the first movement visible to the audience and ends with the exit of the last performer from the stage or the final note/movement of your act. The raised stage dimensions are: 32 ft long x 24 ft deep. The stage floor surface is covered with a marley dance floor, just as it was in past years. The show will also be projected onto large screens for audience enjoyment.

Follies performers who ordered **Follies tickets** may pick them up at the Guest Services Area at WakeMed Stadium on Thursday, September 24 and on Friday, September 25 at McKimmon Center after 12:00 pm. Any tickets not picked-up by Friday at 7:30 p.m. will be sold on a first come/first served basis. Invite your family and friends! Tickets can be ordered until September 15th via your Local Coordinator. Tickets will not be mailed. **Medals** will be presented at intermission and following the performance. Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to solo, small group, and large group in each sub category – vocal, dance, comedy/drama, line dance and instrumental.

There will be a reserved section in the back of the audience for performers only to watch the show live. The show will not be videotaped by NCSG. Photography is permitted by the audience.
