Friday, Sept. 30

A **required “Technical Workshop”** (not a rehearsal) will be held at 2:45 p.m. for acts 22-39 (as numbered below) and at 3:45 p.m. for acts 1-21. Check-in for the *first* workshop will open at 2:15. **Remember, you or the majority of your group, must attend the required Technical Workshop or you will not be permitted to perform in the show. This Workshop will answer all your questions and provide a chance to be on stage and test sound.** All acts must enter stage right. Exceeding the 3-minute time limit will result in disqualification. **Timing** begins with the first note of music or the first movement visible to the audience and ends with the exit of the last performer from the stage or the final note/movement of your act. The raised stage dimensions are 32 ft long x 24 ft deep. The stage floor surface is covered with a marley dance floor, just as it was in past years. The show will be projected onto large screens for audience enjoyment.

Medals will be presented at intermission and at the conclusion of the show. Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to solo, small group, and large group in each subcategory – vocal, dance, comedy/drama, line dance and instrumental. There will be a reserved section in the back of the audience for performers only to watch the show live. The show will not be videotaped by NCSG. Photography *is* permitted by the audience.
