

Ties in Pool Play:

1. In the case of a two-way tie within a pool, the winner of the game between the 2 teams takes the higher place.
2. In the event of a 3 or 4-way tie within a pool, ties will be broken by the sum of the margins of all games within the pool (run differential). If a tie still remains, it will be broken by the total runs accumulated in all games within the pool.
3. A tiebreaker across pools will be determined by the overall run differential.

Exception: If a team forfeits a game during pool play, that team will take the lowest place in a 3 or 4-way tie and all games played by that team will be eliminated from any 3 or 4-way tiebreaker. Resolution of any remaining ties will be determined by the Tournament Officials.
